Instructions for Instrument Reservation:

1. Go to: http://vireo.biology.sjsu.edu/calendar/aspx/bioCalendar.aspx?qName=qGetDeptEvents

2. On left hand side of page, Select "Instrument Schedule", then "Proteomics Facility DH639".

3. Use drop down menu to select instrument you wish to reserve.

4. Select the date on calendar you would like to use instrument.

5. Click "add new", you will be prompted to log-in at this point. If you do not have an account, you will need to set up one. Instructions are provided.

6. Once you are logged in you will be able to select dates and times for individual instrument use. You can reserve blocks of time in 15 minute increments, you will be billed for a minimum use of 15 minutes. NOTE: For the LCMSMS

reservation, under 'notes', indicate the number of samples you will be running during the time you have it reserved. Failure to do this will prompt billing of \$25/15 minutes of instrument time.

7. **IMPORTANT**: You will be billed according to the instrument usage time you reserve. If you need help with this, please speak to the PROTEIN Lab Director ahead of time.
