REGISTER FOR CYBER QUESTS to compete for a spot at the California Cyber Challenge Summer Camp, held at San José State University, August 4–9, 2013!

Cyber Quests is an online competition that takes place April 16–30. It tests students' abilities to identify vulnerabilities in a virtual network and answer questions related to their findings. To register, go to www.uscc.cyberquests.org.

Participants who compete and qualify will get a spot at the California Cyber Challenge Summer Camp. San José State University, in partnership with Visa and the Bay Area Council, will host the camp for up to 100 students. Some students may be eligible for additional prizes and recognition.

At the weeklong camp, students will learn how to evaluate network security and gain firsthand experience detecting intrusions through simulated attacks. Students will also have an opportunity to engage with major technology companies and government agencies at a job fair.
