- Highly proficient in design aspects with excellent working knowledge Adobe Creative Cloud software (In Design, Illustrator, Photoshop, etc.)

- Ability to use current department aesthetic to create new designs and continue to develop the EOP brand
- Ability to manage multiple projects while remaining flexible through multiple revisions while keeping a keen attention to detail
- Must be able to interact, communicate, and present ideas as well as work independently and efficiently
- Undergraduate student enrolled at SJSU at least part time (6 units) and a minimum SJSU cumulative gpa of at least 2.50, and good judicial standing with SJSU
