Case Creation Date:

Incident Summary:

- *It was reported that Alpha Kappa Omega Fraternity has been functioning and recruiting members at SJSU while currently being a suspended organization.*

Student Organization Code of Conduct Violations:

- (08) Failure to Comply
 - (C) Failure to follow all policies and procedures established by the University pertaining to student organizations, including fraternities and sororities, as outlined in the Student Organizations Handbook.
- (23) Violation of Student Organization Conduct Procedures and Sanctions including:
 - (G) Failure to comply with the sanction(s) imposed under a student organization discipline proceeding which may result in further disciplinary action and/or additional sanction(s).

Sanctions:

- **Suspension of Recognition at San José State University through May 31, 2028.**
The student organization, Alpha Kappa Omega Fraternity, is temporarily separated from San José State University, but remains eligible to become a recognized student organization once the suspension has been served. The student organization, Alpha Kappa Omega Fraternity, is to be inactive during the duration of the suspension. Suspension of Recognition is entered on the Student Involvement website (i.e., "Recognized Student Organization (RSO) Conduct"), with beginning and end date.
