# **Incident Summary:**

• The university was made aware that although suspended a Registered Student Organization, Alpha Phi Alpha had placed Greek letters signifying their organizational affiliation on the porch roof of an off-campus house. This action would appear to be a violation of University sanctions.

# **Student Organization Code of Conduct Violations:**

- (23) Violation of Student Organization Conduct Procedures and Sanctions including:
  - (G) Failure to comply with the sanction(s) imposed under a student organization discipline proceeding which may result in further disciplinary action and/or additional sanction(s).

#### **Sanctions:**

### • Written Warning

A Written Warning is an official notice that a particular action or type of behavior is in violation of stated regulations or policies, and is considered unacceptable by the University. The continuation of similar behavior or future violation of community expectations may be cause for more severe disciplinary action.

• Educational Discussion. An educational discussion is an informative conversation aimed at clarifying the institutional expectations of an organization and its members. Specifically, this discussion is to address: (a) university expectations regarding previously issued organization sjsu.edu/communications sanctions; (b) the distinction between university and non-university organizational governance; (c) the nuances of being a fraternity member without operating as or promoting the Epsilon Mu chapter; and (d) the advisory resources (e.g., Student Involvement, SCED, etc.) available to organization members to help facilitate organization compliance with university-imposed sanctions. Note: This educational discussion was satisfied by the Monday, June 24th, 2019 SCED conference meeting.
