Case Creation Date:

- May 20, 2019

Incident Summary:

- *It is alleged that on the weekend of May 11, 2019, Pi Kappa Alpha fraternity had a formal in Las Vegas. Multiple members of your chapter were in attendance. This occurred while Pi Kappa Alpha was on a Cease & Desist and other university sanctions.*

Student Organization Code of Conduct Violations:

- (01) An Unrecognized Group
 - (A) A student organization that assists a group that has lost University recognition, or facilitates the existence of a group that does not have University recognition.
- (01) Violation of University Policy or Law
 - (B) A student organization aiding and abetting another person or group in violation of a University policy or procedure or local, state, or federal law.
- (01) Encouraging, Permitting, Assisting
 - (C) Encouraging, permitting, or assisting another to do any act that could subject him or her to discipline.

Sanctions:

- **Official Warning.**
A Written Warning is an official notice that a particular action or type of behavior is in violation of stated regulations or policies, and is considered unacceptable by the University. The continuation of similar behavior or future violation of community expectations may be cause for more severe disciplinary action.
- **Presentation about Expectation around Unrecognized/Suspended/Expelled Groups by November 29, 2019.** The Executive Board shall create a presentation for members about the expectations for interactions with

Unrecognized/Suspended/Expelled Groups to be presented to 90% of chapter membership. Upon completion of creating the presentation, it must be presented to and approved by the Associate Director in Student Involvement for approval at least 2 weeks prior to presenting to the chapter. The presentation shall be interactive and presented to your membership.
