Incident Summary:

• The reporting student stated that ATO engaged in ongoing hazing practices, including coercive pressure to consume alcohol, mandatory serenading, house-cleaning duties, and purchasing supplies and items for active members. They also reported a secret checklist of required tasks—including dangerous drinking activities and inappropriate challenges—that pledges were expected to complete while the chapter was under a cease-and-desist order. Additional concerns included exposure to drug use within the chapter and unsafe group activities that resulted in at least one pledge needing rescue.

Chapter already closed based on January 2024 incident.
