Incident Summary:

• It is alleged that on or about Thursday, September 22, the University Police
Department received a noise complaint about a party at Alpha Tau Omega fraternity.
It is also alleged this party may have been improperly registered or unregistered, was serving alcohol (unregistered) and ended after the agreed upon time.

Student Organization Code of Conduct Violations:

- (02) Alcohol
 - A copy of the University's Alcohol Policy shall be provided to each student organization president and must be followed. The University's Alcohol Policy is in compliance with California Law, which prohibits the sale or giving of any alcoholic beverage to any person under the age of 21. Student organizations are in violation of University policy if any individuals under the age of 21 are in possession of alcoholic beverages at an activity sponsored/hosted by the student organization and/or if intoxicated individuals consume alcohol. All student organization presidents must sign an agreement to abide by and uphold the University's Alcohol Policy as well as present an alcohol awareness program to their organizations (should be pre-approved by the Prevention Education Program Center) or arrange for an alcohol awareness program approved by the Prevention Education Program Center. Student organizations sponsoring events are responsible for following the appropriate procedures to prevent underage drinking, including providing alternatives to alcohol.
- (12) Guests
 - Student organizations are responsible for informing their guest(s) of University policies and procedures and will be held accountable for the behavior of their guest(s).
- (08)(C) Failure to Comply with Student Organizations Handbook
 - (C) Failure to follow all policies and procedures established by the University

pertaining to student organizations, including fraternities and sororities, as outlined in the Student Organizations Handbook.

• (18) Risk Management of Events

Sanctions:

- Restriction of Social Privileges from November 18, 2022 to June 30, 2023.
 The student organization, Alpha Tau Omega Fraternity, may not sponsor or cosponsor any activity, party, or function which is social in nature. The student organization, Alpha Tau Omega Fraternity, is to be alcohol free during the duration of the restriction of privileges.

Restriction of Social Privileges is entered on the Student Involvement website (i.e., "Recognized Student Organization (RSO) Conduct"), with beginning and end date.

• Probation at the University from November 18, 2022 to December 31, 2023, with the following terms.

With respect to the information listed above, the following additional sanctions/stipulations apply:

Bi-Weekly Meeting with the Director of Student Involvement, or the person's designee, while the organization is on Organization Disciplinary Probation.

The president of the organization is required to attend a bi-weekly check-in meeting with the Director of Student Involvement, or the person's designee, to discuss organization activities

and to establish an organization redevelopment plan (see attached document for reference).
