Student Organization Code of Conduct Violations:

- (8) Failure to comply with Student Organization Handbook
 - (C) Failure to follow all policies and procedures established by the University pertaining to student organizations, including fraternities and sororities, as outlined in the Student Organizations Handbook.

Sanctions:

- Elimination of all in-person activities for the remainder of the 2020-2021 Academic Year. This is in adherence with Student Involvement guidelines already articulated to all Student Organizations.
- COVID-19 Expectation Agreements signed by all members for Spring 2021 and Fall 2021.100% of the chapter membership (active & new members) must sign COVID-19 Expectation Agreements prior to any recruitment activities each semester.
