# **Student Organization Code of Conduct Violations:**

- (08)(C) Failure to Comply with Student Organizations Handbook
  - (C) Failure to follow all policies and procedures established by the University pertaining to student organizations, including fraternities and sororities, as outlined in the Student Organizations Handbook.

## **Sanctions:**

- Formal Warning effective August 3, 2023. No disciplinary action will be taken by Student Conduct and Ethical Development on these charges. As a result of Conference, the student organization was informed of San José State University's policies and procedures; henceforth the student organization is placed on notice and is expected to maintain the community standards of the University.
- Two Follow-up Meetings with the Director of Student Involvement, or the person's designee, to occur during Fall Semester.
  - The president of the organization is required to attend two check-in meetings with the Director of Student Involvement, or their's designee. The president of the organization is responsible for scheduling those meetings. If other members of the organization wish to attend, the president of the organization must first clear the topic with Student involvement.
  - The first meeting should occur in either August or September, and the second meeting can occur anytime before the end of Fall semester.
