Case Creation Date:

- July 5, 2018

Incident Summary:

- Organization's governing organization placed them on a Cease & Desist for falsifying grades. National organization also levied sanctions that the university upheld.

Student Organization Code of Conduct Violations:

- GMM - Chapter Recognition

Sanctions:

- **Warning Status until Convention 2018.** Board has concluded that SJSU – Xi Chapter did falsify member grades for the Spring 2018 semester.
- **Fine.** As stated in the National Handbook Section 4.2C3(d): “A \$250 fine per member for falsifying grades will be enforced.” Due to the falsification of grades, the chapter is to pay a fine of \$500 to the National Treasury by Convention 2018. A payment plan may be arranged with the National Board Treasurer.
- **External and social probation until May 2018.** This includes, but not limited to: exchanges, social/mixer events, support and/or presentations at Formal Installation events outside alpha Kappa Delta Phi International Sorority, Inc. Approval from Officer of Judicial Affairs is required for all external/social events the chapter is interested in participating, supporting, and/or presenting. All mandated events by the University and/or Greek Council would be allowed to attend. Proof may be required.
- **Continue to comply** with the National Risk Management Program and complete all required educational workshops.
- **Host one (1) Academic workshop** focusing on importance of academics to be presented to Greek Council.

- **Chapter is to elect a Chapter Alumnae Advisor** who will aid and support the chapter throughout the probation period and the remainder of the 2017-2018 academic year.
- **Chapter is required to send 51% of the Active house to Convention 2018.** Of this 51%, at least 3 members of next year's Executive Board must be present.
- **Weekly chapter updates.**
