

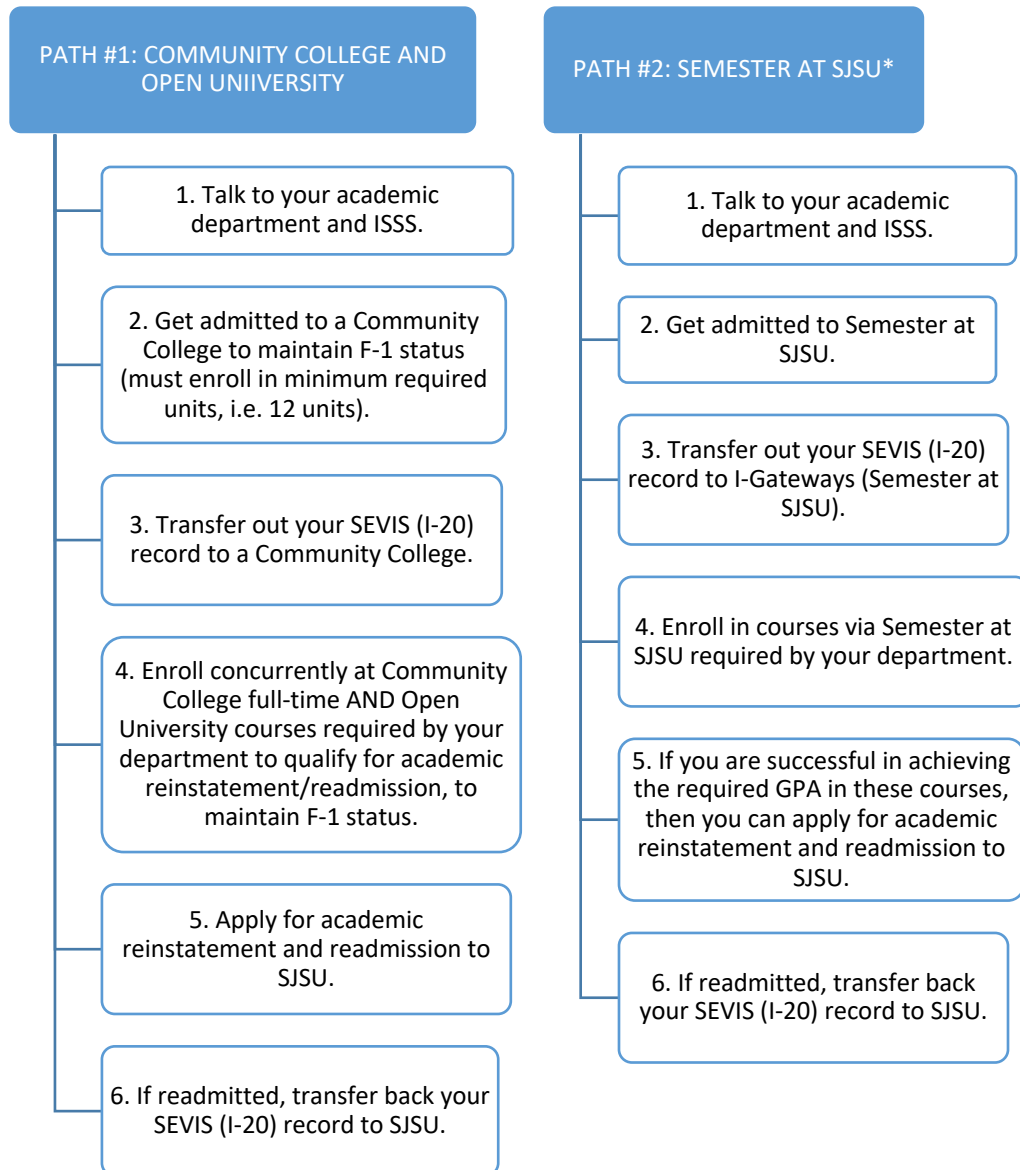

### HOW TO RETURN TO SJSU AFTER ACADEMIC DISQUALIFICATION

**IF YOU ARE OUT OF THE U.S. UPON DISQUALIFICATION, YOU SHOULD NOT TRY TO USE YOUR FORM I-20 TO RETURN TO THE U.S.**

**YOUR SEVIS RECORD WILL BE TERMINATED BY ISSS THE FIRST DAY OF THE UPCOMING SPRING OR FALL SEMESTER IF YOU DO NOT TRANSFER YOUR I-20 TO ANOTHER U.S. SCHOOL. PLEASE TALK TO AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADVISOR AT ISSS BEFORE USING YOUR FORM I-20 TO TRAVEL ABROAD OR APPLY FOR IMMIGRATION BENEFITS IN THE U.S.**

If you are eligible to return to SJSU to continue your studies after you have been academically disqualified, you will need to choose one of the following paths:



***\*If you choose Path #2 Semester at SJSU, you will need to fulfill a 1-year residency requirement to be eligible for practical training (e.g., CPT and OPT) upon readmission. This means that you will have to be enrolled full-time for one academic year after getting reinstated and readmitted to SJSU to be eligible for CPT and OPT. Students who choose path #1 will need to be enrolled for one semester as an F-1 student to be eligible for practical training after they are reinstated/readmitted.***
