2025 Orientation & Transition Team Requirements & Responsibilities

Position Minimum Requirements:

- Be in good academic standing and have a minimum SJSU cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Must be in good standing with the university at the point of application. Issues of probation will be discussed as they arise with consideration for the individual staff member and impact of the team.
- Maintain good academic and disciplinary standing through Fall 2025
- Be a current SJSU student and have passed at least 12 semester units at SJSU prior to Spring 2025
- Complete the mandatory 3-unit UNVS 199 course during the Spring 2024 semester (Tuesdays, 4:30 7:15 pm) beginning Tuesday, January 21, 2025
- Must receive approval to enroll in more than 18 units in Spring 2025
- Will return to SJSU as a student in the Fall 2025 semester
- Relate well with students, parents/family members, staff, faculty, and administrators
- Be reliable, punctual, responsible, flexible, a team player, and demonstrate strong communication skills
- Attend and participate in all orientation team trainings and required events
- Cannot work another on campus job during the Summer 2025
- Adhere to orientation uniform guidelines at all required events
- Cannot be enrolled in summer session classes at SJSU (on campus or online)
- Adhere to student assistant expectations outlined by the department
- Conduct self in a professional manner at all times

Position Responsibilities:

- Dedicate time and energy into the learning, growth, self-discovery, and development of new students
- Communicate effectively and regularly on an individual and group basis with student and professional orientation staff as well as campus partners during the academic year and summer
- Participate in mentorship meetings and activities with Leadership Team members
- Work ALL orientation sessions (Dates and specific duties TBD):
 - Be available for all orientation sessions hosted during the summer of 2025
 - Serve as a small group leader during new student orientation sessions
 - Work individually and in teams to provide operational support
 - o Articulate knowledge of campus resources and programs to new Spartans
 - o Be a reliable, punctual, responsible, collaborative, and caring team member
 - Be highly motivated, dependable, and sincere in representing SJSU and NSFP
- Complete assessment surveys and evaluations throughout the year as requested
- Participate and support various campus events and initiatives as requested by orientation, the Division of Student Affairs, and wider SJSU campus departments (Admitted Spartan Day, etc.)
- Required to continue as a Spartan Spark Leader in Fall 2025 Semester
- Adhere to student assistant expectations outlined by the department
- Other duties as assigned

Total Compensation:

Wages

- \$17.55 per hour (pay is subject to state and federal taxes)
- Summer Hours:
 - June and July 2025: Up to 40 hours a week
 - August 2025: Up to 20 hours a week
 - o September 2025 December 2025: Up to 10-15 hours a week
- Employment Period: January 2024 December 2024

Housing & Meals Package
