- Education
- Support groups/Moral Reconciliation Therapy groups

In-Custody Eligibility:

- Release date within 45 days
- Unemployed at release and/or no permanent housing in place
- Referral through Rehabilitation Officer

Community Eligibility:

- Released from custody in the last month
- Unemployed and/or no permanent housing in place
- Referral from County Reentry Resource Center
- Referral from Probation or Parole Department
